

Greetings from Red Rocks Community College,

Good news! Your son or daughter is enrolled in a Concurrent Enrollment course at their high school. Concurrent Enrollment is a state program which allows high school students in grades 9-12 to take classes for dual credit (high school and college credit) with the college tuition paid by the school district through state funding.

Your child's high school instructor meets the same eligibility requirements as a Red Rocks Community College (RRCC) adjunct instructor and will be teaching the class, aligning the high school curriculum to RRCC's. The college credit earned is permanently recorded on a RRCC college transcript.

The college tuition which is typically \$144 per credit hour will be covered by the school district so students earn college credit at no cost! For a 3 college credit course, this is a value of over \$400!

To earn the college credit, students will complete the following steps:

Apply:

First, need to complete a free online RRCC application at www.rrcc.edu/admissions. The application will establish an account at the college for your student. To complete the application, students will need their social security number and residency information from a parent.

*Please be sure to say "YES" when asked if you would like to also establish a [College Opportunity Fund](#) account. While the district pays the college tuition, they will only pay the portion of tuition after the College Opportunity Fund stipend has been applied and reduced the tuition.

Submit paperwork to register:

A Concurrent Enrollment Agreement, pre-signed by the high school administration, will be coming home for you to review and sign with your child. The required agreement form must be complete and submitted to RRCC in order to register for the college credit.

Soon, a RRCC representative will be visiting your child's class to assist with enrollment and to collect paperwork. If you would like for your son or daughter to take advantage of this great opportunity to start a college transcript, please start working on the application with them on the steps listed above.

The registration deadline for fall is: **September 6, 2017**
